EXPLORE PANAMA

What to do and where to go in Panama City

ITIC Americas 2024 takes us to the Sofitel Legend hotel in the historic, colourful neighbourhood of Casco Viejo. *Alysia Cameron-Davies* suggests how to make the most of your time in the city

One of Panama City's most interesting locations, Casco Viejo, also known as Casco Antiguo or the old quarter, is a UNESCO World Heritage site. When you leave your hotel, explore the cobblestone streets and discover the colonial architecture, lively plazas, and fantastic gastronomy. Here we suggest places you may like to visit during your stay in the city.

RESTAURANTS AND ROOFTOP BARS

Santa Rita in the Casco Viejo district is the perfect place to sample the flavours of Spanish tapas fused with Argentinean cuisine.


Another great choice is Mahalo Cocina y Jardin, which specialises in international gastronomy centred around healthy dishes, and has a great cosy atmosphere.

A short distance from the Sofitel hotel you can find several lively rooftop bars with restaurant facilities offering food, cocktails, panoramic views, and sometimes live music. The best spots include: Sama Sky Lounge; Tantalo; CasaCasco; Lazotea; and El Faro del Casco Antiguo (the Old Lighthouse). Panaviera Sky Bar at the Ocean Casino is located on the 66th floor of the PH TOC International Hotel &

Tower, and is the highest rooftop bar in Central America. At the weekends, live music and a DJ create a vibrant atmosphere. Barstyle food and appetisers are available.

Outside of Casco Viejo, Maito is ranked sixth on the 2023 Latin America's 50 Best Restaurants list. The diverse menu boasts a fusion of flavours influenced by Panama's multicultural culinary scene.

If you fancy a new concept in Japanese signature cuisine, Salvaje could be a great choice. Translating as 'Wild' in English, this venue is exactly that – a unique dining experience. Indulge in sushi and Japanese-



inspired dishes while staff perform energetic dances, dressed in costume, accompanied by a DJ.

For an Italian fine dining experience with a spectacular seafront view, make your way to La Vespa Vistamare. Or, if you prefer French cuisine, La Boucherie is a popular option.

HISTORY AND CULTURE


As well as great gastronomy, Panama City has a dynamic cultural scene.

Five minutes from the Sofitel Legend, you can find one of the country's most visited museums: the Panama Canal Museum (Museo del Canal Interoceánico de Panamá). Housed in what was once the headquarters for French and US companies involved in the canal's construction, it's a great place to immerse yourself in the history and culture of Panama.

The famous Altar de Oro (the Golden Altar) can be found in San Jose Church, also in Casco Viejo. Although research suggests this may not be the original altar from the legend, it is still regarded as a religious and cultural treasure.

If you're interested in the city's early history, head to the Patronato Panamá Viejo. Located on the east side of the city, here you can visit the ancient ruins of the original settlement and gain insight into the pre- and post-colonial evolution of Panama.

For enthusiasts of both architecture and natural history, the Biomuseo is a must. The building itself is iconic, built by the famous architect Frank Gehry. Inside you can explore the exhibitions and learn about Panama's biodiversity and its global impact.



Within walking distance of the Biomuseo is the Amador Causeway. From the promenade, you can look out over Panama Bay and observe ships as they queue up to enter the Panama Canal.

NATURE AND DAY TRIPS

Panama City is home to the only urban natural park in Latin America, so if you fancy a stroll amid lush greenery, Parque Natural Metropolitano is the perfect place.

The sandy shores of Taboga Island lie just 20 kilometres away from the city. The island is a favoured spot for tourists and locals seeking a relaxed beach day within arm's reach of the city. It's easily accessible by ferry, or through an organised tour. Ferries depart frequently from the Amador Causeway and get you to the island in 30 minutes.

Join our fantastic Jungle Experience at 2:00pm on Saturday 2 March for a four-hour-long jungle trip and tour of the Panama Canal.

GETTING AROUND THE CITY

The most reliable taxi services are Uber and Cabify. Areas to avoid walking through at night are El Chorrillo, Santa Ana, and Calidonia.
